The incumbent will serve as the Swim Instructor for an eight-week summer enrichment camp, Camp Inspiration, June 17 - August 9, 2024, Monday-Friday, for children, ages 6 - 12. May also provide swim instruction for non-camp participants, through September 2^{nd} , as determined. The incumbent will work nine (9) days out of a two-week camp session; swimming will not be held on the days of the field trips.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Evaluates each camper's performance during initial swim sessions to determine level of knowledge, i.e., children who do not know how to swim and those children with varying swimming abilities.
- Teaches children and adults to develop proper swimming strokes and techniques. Identifies incorrect swimming techniques and corrects swimmer accordingly.
- Teaches water safety rules to all swimmers. Monitors the swimmers to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Assists more advanced swimmers to enhance their swimming abilities.
- Completes attendance, progress and accident reports and ensures the Camp Director is informed promptly.
- Ensures that all swimming aids and equipment are in good order.
